INDICATIONS

Forms a protective film that, adhering to the mucosa, insulates the wound from the external environment and keeps it in pH and moisture levels ideal for faster repair.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Apply a thin layer of gel to the injured oral mucosa, where necessary spreading the gel with a swab or clean and dry fingers to ensure a correct and even distribution.

Repeat the treatment at least twice a day after meals, having previously carried out appropriate oral hygiene. Continue applying until the symptoms disappear.
